In these uncertain times where component lead-times are fluctuating so much the sourcing engineer needs to be in constant discussion with suppliers to understand and keep an up-to-date database of component availability and longevity.

### **KEY ACTIVITIES:**

- Take a PCB bill of materials and understand component availability and lead-times based on build dates and required product quantities provided.
- Build a relationship with all suppliers so an up-to-date database of component lead-times is always available.
- Negotiate with suppliers for the best possible delivery dates.
- Provide details of component alternatives where appropriate.
- Based on discussions with suppliers inform details on all component longevity.
- Provide costs based on costing a bill of materials.
- Liaise, share and communicate information with Far Eastern factory purchasing teams.
